Hurline Solutions. ("Hurline Solutions", "Us", "We" or "Our") respects the privacy of the visitors to the Site. User Consent

Your Personal Information may be processed by Us in the country where it was collected as well as other countries (including the United States) where laws regarding processing of Personal Information may be less stringent than the laws in Your country.

Collection of Personal Information

The Personal Information We gather from You helps Us learn about visitors to the Site, Our customers and potential customers. We use this information to better tailor the features, performance and support of Our products and services, to offer You additional information and opportunities.

Training or Workshop Registration

These third parties do not have any right to use the Personal Information We provide to them beyond what is necessary to assist Us in processing payments.

Personal Information You Provide to Us

We collect Personal Information that You submit to Us voluntarily through the Site.

- If You are registering as a conference attendee via the Site, we collect all of (without limitation) the following information You provide to us: your first and last names, e-mail address, mailing address, business, title, phone number, fax number, and business address, if different from your mailing address.
- When You contact Us by sending Us an e-mail, We collect Your name, e-mail address and information contained in the e-mail You send us.

Personal Information Collected Via Technology

As You navigate the Site, certain information may also be collected passively, including Your Internet protocol address ("IP address"), browser type, domain names, access times, and operating system. We also use "Cookies" and navigational data like Uniform Resource Locators (URLs) to gather information regarding the date and time of Your visit and the information for which You searched and

which You viewed. This type of information is collected to make Our products and services more useful to You.

An “IP Address” is a number that is automatically assigned to Your computer when You use the Internet. In some cases Your IP Address stays the same from browser session to browser session; but if You use a consumer internet access provider, Your IP Address probably varies from session to session. We track IP Addresses solely in conjunction with session cookies to analyze the traffic on our Site.

“Cookies” are small pieces of information that a website sends to Your computer’s hard drive while You are viewing a website. We may use both session Cookies (which expire once You close Your web browser) and persistent Cookies (which stay on Your computer until You delete them) to provide You with a more personal and interactive experience on the Site. Persistent Cookies can be removed by following Internet browser help file directions. If You choose to disable Cookies, some areas of the Site may not work properly.

Personal Information We Receive From Other Sources

We may receive Personal Information about You from other sources like postal mail, telephone or fax. We may add this information to the information We have already collected from You via the Site in order to improve the services We provide.

Use of Information

Unless You affirmatively elect not to receive (“opt-out”) the following communications from Us, Personal Information You submit to Us is used either to respond to requests that You make, send You general informative announcements, Our newsletters and other general information about Us or Our services. You will be given the opportunity to opt-out of receiving further communication from Us at the bottom of every e-mail We send to You.

We may create Anonymous Information records from Personal Information by excluding information (such as Your name) that make the information personally identifiable to You. We may use this Anonymous Information to analyze request patterns and usage patterns so that We may enhance Our products and services. We reserve the right to use and Anonymous Information.

Feedback
